Seminole State College, East Central University Hire Shared English Instructor

 Seminole State College (SSC) and East Central University (ECU) recently began a partnership to share the employment of a full-time English instructor. This partnership is an example of successful partnerships between our institutions to better address the needs of our students. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the Oklahoma Legislature.

In an effort to focus on our existing workload, we traveled outside positions that will be more. The English position was approved by the Board of Regents for East Central University. The shared position is located approximately 40% of the time at ECU and 60% at SSC, and will impact 15 hours of average annual course work per year for SSC and 10 hours for ECU.

SSC and ECU have a long history of working together to provide students with an integrated program for our students' education. Our campuses have previously worked together to create a shared program for students seeking an education degree, and the shared faculty position for the English program shows our continued dedication to share resources, grow our partnerships and most importantly, better serve our students.

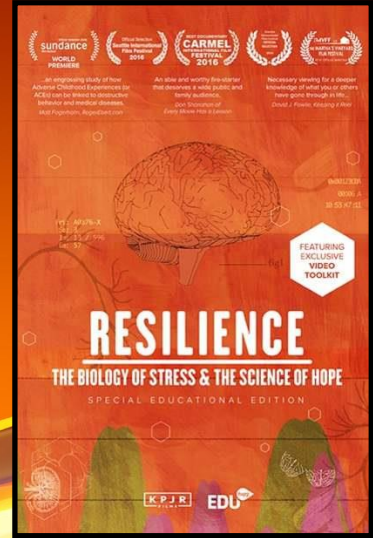
Connors State College Forms Nursing Program Partnership

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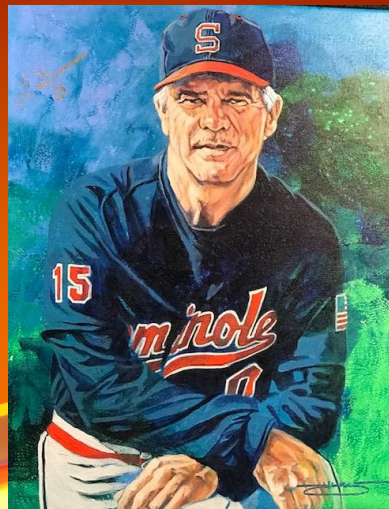

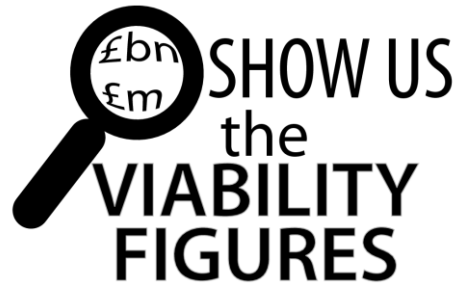
