


# Q1 With SSC's recent announcement that face coverings will be required and social distancing measures will be utilized, how comfortable do you feel returning to campus for classes this fall?







### **Innovative Higher Education Partnerships**

### Seminole State College, East Central University Hire Shared English Instructor

Seminole State College (SSC) and East Central University (ECU) recently began a partnership to share the employment of a full-time English instructor. Sharing this amployee is an example of a unique parlmenthip between our institutions to bottor utilize resources allocated by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the Oklahoma Legislature.

In an effort to focus on cost-saving services, we reviewed possible positions that could be shared. The English position was a great fit – filling a need we had at both institutions. The shared position will devote approximately 40% of service time to ECU and 60% to SSC, and will teach 15 hours of language, arts courses each year for SSC and hold offlice hours on cannous.

SSC and ECU have a long history of working together to provide academic and ubularal programs for our students and communifies. Our compuses have proviously worked together to oracte a smooth harastion for students seeking an education degree, and the shared faculty member for our English programs shows our continued desire to share resources, grow our partnerships and, most importantly before sorve our subdems.

### Connors State College Forms Nursing Program Partnership Dr. Ron Ramming, President, Connors State College


