

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria and Descriptions

SCHOLARSHIPS REQUIRING THIS APPLICATION

ACT Scholarship: Students scoring 30+ on the ACT may apply for Tuition waiver plus \$3600 scholarship to be used at the rate of \$900 for, FOUR semesters, provided the student maintains a 3.25 or better GPA each semester while being enrolled full-time. Application Deadline: April 1st.

Valedictorian Scholarship:

High School Seniors, who will be students next year, ranking Valedictorian, may apply for the Tuition, Fees, and Books scholarship to be used FOUR semesters, providing the student maintains a 3.20 or better GPA each semester while being enrolled full-time. Application Deadline: April 1st.

Salutatorian Scholarship: High School Seniors, who will be students next year, ranking Salutatorian, may apply for the Tuition and Fees scholarship to be used FOUR semesters, providing the student maintains a 3.20 or better GPA each semester while being enrolled full-time. Application Deadline: April 1st.

Academic Excellence Scholarship: High School Seniors, who will be students next year, with a GPA of 3.70 to 4.00 may apply for Tuition Waiver to be used FOUR semesters, providing the student maintains a 3.20 or better GPA each semester, while being enrolled full-time. Application Deadline: April 1st.

Director Scholarship: High School Seniors, who will be students next year, may apply for Tuition Waiver to be used FOUR semesters, providing the student maintains a 3.20 or better GPA each semester, while being enrolled full-time. Applicants must submit a 500 word essay (approximately one page) stating the reasons why they should receive the scholarship with application. Application Deadline: April 1st.

Perseverance Scholarship: Non-Traditional students may apply for Tuition waiver to be used FOUR semesters, providing the student maintains a 3.20 or better GPA each semester, while being enrolled full-time. Applicants must submit a 500 word essay (approximately one page) stating the reasons why they should receive the scholarship with application. Application Deadline: April 1st.

Departmental Scholarship: Students may apply for a Tuition waiver to be used TWO semesters, providing the student maintains a 3.20 or better GPA each semester while being enrolled full-time. Application Deadline: April 1st.

Transfer Student Scholarship: Students will have completed a total of 24 post secondary credit hours (clock hours be translated) from an accredited higher education institution or vocational technology center with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7.

Jimmie & Marie Austin Scholarship: Students may apply for the scholarship with preference to Seminole County Oil Industry families. Application Deadline : April 1st.

Mt. View Alumni Scholarship: Rural High School Seniors, who will be students next year, may apply for the scholarship with first preference going to New Lima High School and then to other Seminole County Rural High Schools. Application Deadline: April 1st.

Edwin & Helen Roesler Scholarship: Entering Freshman students who are first priority a resident of Seminole, or second priority, a resident of Seminole County may apply for the \$1000 scholarship to be used for TWO semesters.

Walking Stick Scholarship: This scholarship is aimed toward female Native American students. Applicants must be an Oklahoma resident, maintain full time enrollment and carry a 3.0 cumulative grade point average. Application Deadline: April 1

Dan Wallace Scholarship: High school seniors, who will be SSC students next year and graduated from Seminole High School. First priority will be awarded to students based on academic performance and ACT scores.

SCHOLARSHIPS REQUIRING SEPARATE APPLICATIONS

*** APPLICATIONS CAN BE OBTAINED IN THE FINANCIAL AID OFFICE.**

SSC Presidential Leadership Scholarship: High school seniors, who will be SSC students the next year, may apply for the tuition, room and board scholarship to be used Four semesters. **Qualifying candidates must be nominated by their high school.** Preferred qualifications: Score of 20 or better on ACT, high ranking in high school graduating class. Successful applicants will be required to live on campus, participate in the leadership program, and apply for FAFSA. Financial aid awards will be applied prior to the awarding of this scholarship.

Faculty Senate Scholarship*: SSC students who have completed 24 college credit hours may apply for a Tuition waiver to be used TWO semesters. Apply, separately spring semester, recommendations required, and a committee will interview students.

Permanent Issue (Band) Scholarship: Students may apply for a Tuition waiver to be used each semester after audition selection, providing the student enrolls in "Performance Techniques" and maintains a 2.5 or better cumulative GPA while being enrolled full-time. No Application Deadline, apply directly with the Permanent Issue Sponsor.

Social Science Division Scholarship*: Two-semester Fall/Spring tuition waiver scholarship. Students not receiving other SSC scholarships; who have cumulative college GPA of 3.0 and sophomore standing (27 hrs. completed) by end of current spring semester; and declared major in the social sciences, may apply. Application deadline: April 1.

Professional Staff/Kay Edwards Memorial Scholarship*: SSC students may apply for a \$200 scholarship to be used during the SUMMER semester. Apply separately spring semester.

Classified Staff Scholarship*: SSC students or students entering their second year may apply for a \$250 scholarship to be used TWO semesters, providing the students enroll full-time. Preference to SSC classified staff family members. Apply separately spring semester.

Moran Nursing Scholarship*: Second year Nursing students may apply for the \$1000 scholarship to be used for TWO semesters, providing the student maintains a nursing major, has a current 3.0 GPA and minimum ACT of 20. Apply separately within the Nursing Office.

Eloise Wright Nursing Scholarship*: Second year nursing students may apply for the scholarship, providing the student maintains academic achievement. Apply separately within the Nursing Office.

Ambassador Scholarship*: Second year students may apply for a Tuition waiver to be used TWO semesters after nomination on leadership abilities and interview with 3 references provided. Students must have and maintain a 2.5 or better cumulative GPA. Apply separately spring semester. Only 5 awarded.

Neil Molleur Leadership Development Scholarship: By invitation only, students may be eligible for \$600 to be used for TWO semesters at \$300 each semester, providing the student enrolls in Hum 2333, completes 40 hours of community service, and maintains a 3.0 or better GPA each semester while being enrolled full-time. Application procedure is handled through the President's office.

Collegian (Newspaper) Scholarship: Students may apply for a tuition waiver to be used each semester, providing the student is enrolled full-time. The student must supply a letter of recommendation and have past experience in journalism/media relations. Apply directly with Media Relations. Application Deadline-none.
