Scholarship Eligibility Criteria and Descriptions

PRIORITY DEADLINE: MARCH 1. WHILE YOU MAY APPLY FOR MULTIPLE SCHOLARSHIPS, MOST SCHOLARSHIP CANNOT BE COMBINED OR STACKED.

Please check the box of all of the scholarships that you are interested in. If the scholarship has additional requirements (ie. essay), you must provide those materials WITH this scholarship application!

ACT Scholarship

Students scoring 30+ on the ACT may apply for tuition waiver plus \$3600 scholarship to be used at the rate of \$900 over FOUR semesters; must maintain a 3.25 or better GPA each semester while being enrolled full-time.

Valedictorian Scholarship

Award: \$5,000 over four semesters (\$1,250 per fall/spring semester). High School Seniors who will attend SSC in the fall; Valedictorian of their class; ACT Composite of 21 or higher; must maintain a 3.20 or better GPA each semester while being enrolled full-time. Covers in-state and out-of-state portions of tuition if applicable.

Salutatorian Scholarship

Award: \$4,000 over four semesters (\$1,000 per fall/spring semester). High School Seniors who will attend SSC in the fall; Salutatorian of their class; ACT composite of 19 or higher; must maintain a 3.20 or better GPA each semester while being enrolled full-time. Covers in-state and out-of-state portions of tuition if applicable.

Vice President's Scholarship

Award: \$4,000 over four semesters (\$1,000 per fall/spring semester). Open to recent high school graduates as well as transfer students with a minimum 3.0 GPA from high school or college as applicable; minimum ACT composite of 19 preferred; recipients must be enrolled full-time and maintain a 3.0 GPA; **recipients must live on campus.** Covers in-state and out-of-state portions of tuition if applicable.

Academic Excellence Scholarship

Award: \$3,000 over four semesters (\$750 per fall/spring semester). High School Seniors with a GPA of 3.70 to 4.00 who will attend SSC in the fall; student must maintain a 3.00 or better GPA each semester while being enrolled full-time. Covers in-state and out-of-state portions of tuition if applicable.

Dean's Scholarship

Award: \$2,000 over four semesters (\$500 per fall/spring semester); High School Seniors who will attend SSC in the fall; student must maintain a 3.00 or better GPA each semester while being enrolled full-time. **Applicants must submit a 500 word essay (approximately one page) stating the reasons why they should receive the scholarship.**

Perseverance Scholarship (Non-Traditional Student)

Award: \$2,000 over four semesters (\$500 per fall/spring semester);

For non-traditional students who will attend SSC in the fall; student must maintain a 3.00 or better GPA each semester while being enrolled full-time. Funds will be applied to the costs of attendance. **Applicants must submit a 500 word essay (approximately one page) stating the reasons why they should receive the scholarship.**

Transfer Student Scholarship

Award: \$2,000 over four semesters (\$500 per fall/spring semester);

Students will have completed a total of 24 postsecondary credit hours (clock hours are translated) from an accredited higher education institution or vocational technology center with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7.

Agricultural Science Scholarship

Award: \$1,000 over two semesters (\$500 per fall/spring semester);

Applicants must major in Agricultural Science. Outstanding leadership and FFA participation required; student must maintain a 2.5 or better GPA each semester while being enrolled full-time. **A list of FFA activities and awards must be included with this application, along with a letter of recommendation from their high school agriculture teacher.**

Foundation Scholarships (all require a minimum 3.0 GPA)

Jimmie & Marie Austin Scholarship: Students may apply for this scholarship that gives preference to Seminole County Oil Industry families.

Mt. View Alumni Scholarship: Rural High School Seniors, who will attend SSC in the fall, may apply for the scholarship with first preference going to New Lima High School and then to other Seminole County Rural High Schools.

Edwin & Helen Roesler Scholarship: Entering Freshman students who are first priority a resident of Seminole and Seminole HS graduate, or second priority, a resident of Seminole County may apply for the \$1000 scholarship to be used for TWO semesters.

Walkingstick Scholarship: This scholarship is aimed toward female Native American students. Applicants must be an Oklahoma resident, maintain full time enrollment and carry a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.

Dan Wallace Scholarship: High school seniors, who will be SSC students next year and graduated from Seminole High School. First priority will be awarded to students based on academic performance and ACT scores.

Langley Family Scholarship: Awarded to high school seniors or non-traditional students from Seminole and Pottawatomie counties; based on academic performance; school, civic and community involvement; and, need.

Wayne & Hazel Reynolds Scholarship: Awarded to high school seniors or non-traditional students from the Seminole area; based on academic performance; school, civic and community involvement; and, need.

SSC Presidential Leadership Scholarship*

Award: \$10,000 over four semesters (\$2,500 per fall/spring semester)

High school seniors who will attend SSC in the fall may apply for the President's Leadership Class (PLC). **Qualifying candidates must be nominated by their high school.** Preferred Qualifications: Score of 20 or better on ACT, high ranking in his/her graduating class. A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required to qualify and remain in good standing in the PLC program. Successful applicants will be **required to live on campus**, be enrolled full-time and actively participate in the leadership program. Deadline: Late January. Call (405) 382-9200 for application and exact date.

Faculty Senate Scholarship

Award: Provides up to \$1000 per semester (fall/spring) that may be applied to SSC tuition or required textbooks charged through the SSC bookstore; SSC students who have completed 24 college credit hours may apply; recommendations and committee interview required; apply separately spring semester. Permanent Issue (Band) Scholarship

Award: \$1,000 per fall/spring semester (up to \$4,000 over four semesters based on band selection); Students may apply each semester after audition selection providing the student enrolls in "Performance Techniques" and maintains a 2.0 or better cumulative GPA while being enrolled full-time. Recipients under 21 years old must also live on campus. No Application Deadline. Contact Travis Qualls at t.qualls@sscok.edu for application.

Campus Activities Board (CAB) Scholarship

Award: \$1,000 over two semesters (\$500 per fall/spring semester) Qualifications: Student must have outstanding leadership abilities, great energy and a flexible schedule to help a few hours (days or evenings) per month. Students in CAB will help plan and promote campus activities and events, as well as give campus tours. Students applying must complete an essay; give 3 references; and go through an interview selection process. Student must have and maintain a 2.5 GPA or better and be enrolled in 12 hours or more. Only 5 awarded. Contact Melinda Sims at m.sims@sscok.edu for application.

Academic Division Scholarship

Award: \$1,000 over two semesters (\$500 per fall/spring semester) Each SSC academic division may award scholarships to deserving students. Funds will be applied to the costs of attendance. Eligibility criteria and application deadlines vary by division. Contact the division office for your major for more information.

Collegian (Newspaper) Scholarship

Award: Up to \$2,000 over four semesters (\$500 per fall/spring semester) Applicants must supply a letter of recommendation and have past experience in journalism/media relations; must be enrolled full-time. Funds will be applied to the costs of attendance. Contact Kristin Dunn at k.dunn@sscok.edu for application. Application Deadline: None.

Professional Staff/Kay Edwards Memorial Scholarship: SSC students may apply for a \$400 scholarship to be used during the SUMMER semester. Apply in the spring semester. Contact Julie Hix at j.hix@sscok.edu for application.

Classified Staff Scholarship: SSC students or students entering their second year may apply for a \$250 scholarship to be used TWO semesters, providing the student is enroll full-time. Preference to SSC classified staff family members. Apply separately spring semester. Contact Ann Gavin at a.gavin@sscok.edu for application.

Moran Nursing Scholarship: Second year Nursing students may apply for the \$1000 scholarship to be used for TWO semesters, providing the student maintains a nursing major, has a current 3.0 GPA and minimum ACT of 20. Contact the Nursing Office at 405-382-9287 for application.

Eloise Wright Nursing Scholarship: Second year nursing students may apply for the scholarship, providing the student maintains academic achievement. Contact the Nursing Office at (405) 382-9287 for application.

Neil Molleur Leadership Development Scholarship: By invitation only, students may be eligible for \$600 to be used for TWO semesters at \$300 each semester, providing the student enrolls in Hum 2333, completes 40 hours of community service, and maintains a 3.0 or better GPA each semester while being enrolled full-time.
