**Submit the following to the SSC Office of Admissions:**

## **An application for admission**

*Available to print online or from the Admissions Office*

*Return completed form with \$15 application fee to the Admissions Office*

## **Your high school transcript**

*Must show date of graduation, or proof your high school class has graduated*

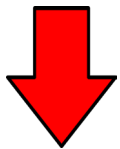
## **ACT scores OR visit the SSC Testing Office for placement testing**

*ACT scores cannot be more than five years old*

*Students with ACT scores over a year old may be required to take math placement tests*

## **Your official college transcripts**

*If transferring from another college, you will need to request an official, final transcript from that institution (and all other colleges previously attended) to give to SSC*

## **An Academic Advisor**

*They will help you select the classes you want. This is the fun part!*

## **A Financial Aid Specialist**

*Ask about completing your FAFSA and available scholarship opportunities.*
