Please cooperate with the staff by always having your membership identification card with you and presenting it to the building staff or campus security when requested to do so.

**Waiver of Liability**

### Notes about membership:

1. Members may only swim during "faculty/staff" or "open swim" times. These times are posted on the door near the North entrance to the pool inside the gym. They will also be posted on the Seminole State College website each semester. Hours can and may vary week to week in case of other events at the Field House.
2. "Faculty/Staff" or "Open Swim" may be closed on certain occasions such as:
  - a. Bad weather – any time there is lightening in the area, pools must be closed a minimum of 30 minutes before reopening. Other serious weather could close the pool entirely temporarily.
  - b. Seminole State Athletic events – sometimes these events require the use of our locker rooms, therefore closing the pool area so there are no conflicts.
  - c. Unavailable staff – If a staff member is not able to make it to work, on rare occasions we may need to close the pool at the last minute due to lack of available staff.
  - d. Other occasions may arise, and we apologize for any inconvenience.
3. As stated on the previous page, all members who come to "Faculty/Staff" or "Open Swim" **MUST** show their membership card given to them by Pool Manager Brian Nelson. If a Family Membership is purchased, each member of the Family will receive an ID card and all must show upon arrival.
4. We are NOT responsible for any items left in the lockers, locker room, on tables, or around the deck of the pool. If you bring something, make sure to take it with you.
5. The only door open to enter for "faculty/staff" or "open swim" will be the North door leading into the gym. The reason for this is to make sure members "check-in" at the desk by this door and to show proper identification to the lifeguard.

### Seminole State Pool Rules:

1. No children under 18 years of age may swim without an accompanied adult.
2. Prior to entering the pool, members must check in with the lifeguard and show ID card. Also the member(s) must sign in at the desk.
3. A cleansing bath, using warm water and soap, must be taken in the locker rooms before entering the pool.
4. No one may swim with any open wounds, bandages, or any symptoms of communicable disease.
5. Proper swimming attire must be worn, no jeans.
6. Seminole State College is an alcohol and drug free campus. This also includes smokeless cigars or vapor-less cigars.
7. No animals are allowed in the building.
8. Safety equipment such as a handicap ramp and lift chair are provided, but must not be used or tampered with unless needed.
9. Running and rough play are not allowed around the deck of the pool or in the water.
10. No diving in shallow water.
11. Lifeguard can and may use a swim proficiency test at any time.
12. No inflatables allowed in the pool.
13. Members should not enter the pool area until the start of the class, program, or "faculty/staff" or "open swim" time. Make sure the Lifeguard is always on deck before entering into the pool.
