

## Seminole State College Language Arts and Humanities Placement Cut Scores

- Students are permitted to take a placement test in a subject no more than twice each term.
- Forty-eight hours must elapse before a student may retake a placement test.
- For each subject area, there is no charge for the first placement test administered. For each retake of a placement test, there is a \$5 fee.

- No: Use Multiple Measures English Rubric (MMER)

#### MULTIPLE MEASURES ENGLISH RUBRIC (MMER)

- Yes: Use score to determine course to take:
- Score 12-17: Take ENG 1113 (Comp I) – college-level English
- Score 0-11: Take ENG 0203 (Special Topics in Composition) with ENG 1113 (Comp I) – college-level English with remediation (must pass both to earn college-level English credit)
