

About the Access Lab

SSC NASNTI has established an Access Lab on campus to provide flexible access to computers equipped with assistive devices and software for students with disabilities. **The lab is available to all students at SSC whether you are a remote or in-person learner and regardless of your disability status.**

The lab is open Monday-Friday from 8am-4pm (closed on Friday's in the summer).

The lab does not offer tutoring or mentoring services **BUT** the Lab Assistants will: **1)** instruct students on how to use the assistive technology devices, **2)** demonstrate how to access Microsoft assistive technology software and additional software for academic disability challenges, and **3)** teach students how to use assistive tools through the NASNTI Assistive Device Loaner Program.

No appointment is necessary for individual students to utilize the lab.

The ViewBoard

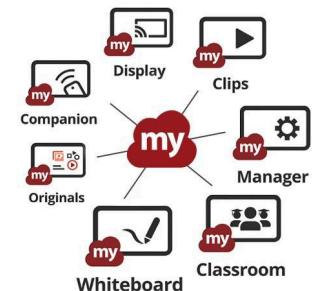


The ViewBoard by ViewSonic is an interactive tool that provides the ultimate digital whiteboard solution for collaboration and learning.
