


SEMINOLE STATE COLLEGE NON-FACULTY SATISFACTION SURVEY




The Non-Faculty Satisfaction Survey was administered in spring 2019 for the first time. The two-fold purpose of the survey was to determine the satisfaction rating of non-faculty on campus items and to get input for future endeavors from the non-faculty. The survey was administered through the efforts of the Assessment of Student Learning Committee.

Participants

Sixty-one percent of non-faculty employees at SSC completed the Non-Faculty Satisfaction Survey. The survey consisted of 62 questions with multiple opportunities for comments.

The following chart shows the responses to survey questions. The percentages reflect those participants answering “strongly agree” or “agree”.
