The Native Americans Serving Non-Tribal Institutions (NASNTI), provides tutoring services to SSC Tribal members, and students enrolled in Academics Learning Strategies, Fundamentals of Language Arts or English Composition I or English Composition II. We recognize that the classroom experience is the epicenter for student learning.

With our newly developed Engagement Center, NASNTI offers SSC Students: *Peer Mentoring, Student Success Workshops, Cultural Events/Activities and a Tutoring Program.*

Our Tutoring Program is designed to supplement classroom instruction, enhance student learning, and increase learning outcomes.

Our tutors focus on teaching core concepts that will empower tutees to understand course content, improve test scores and to successfully complete their courses.

Targeted to be a designated **'hotspot'** to complete homework assignments; the Tutoring Program will offer four tutoring modalities: walk-ins, individual, group and recommended online applications.

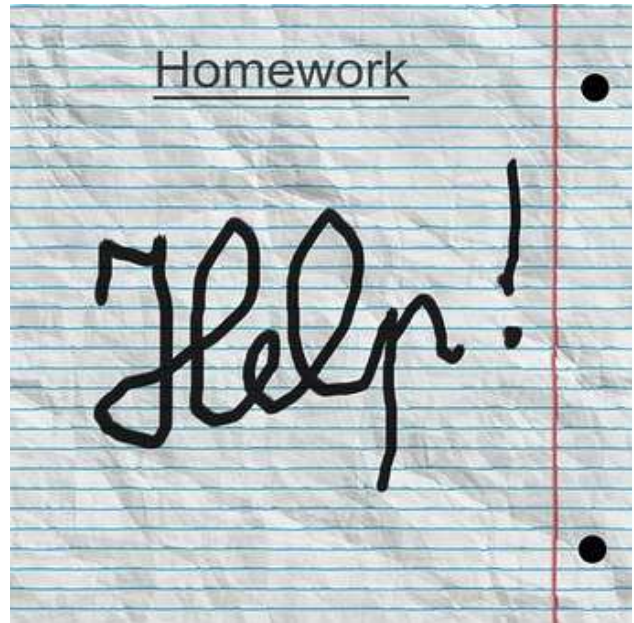
Tutoring Program Objectives
