

Budget FY25 Talking Points


Revenue

- 1.57% increase in state appropriations (property insurance subsidy)
- No tuition or fee increases for students
- Flat operational budget
- Increased enrollment for Summer 2024 of 11% in credit hours
- Better payment options and collections on student accounts
- Savings on Administration Restructuring
- Deferred Maintenance appropriations


Budget FY25 Talking Points

Expenses


- FLSA salary requirement costs
- *1% Cost of Living raise campus wide
- 30% increase in property insurance
- 7% increase in utilities
- New longevity schedule payments
- Division Chair stipend increases








FY25 Educational and General Expenditures by Object




FY25 Educational & General Expenditures By Function






FY 24-25 Salary Raises







- Vote to Return to Open Session


