TOPIC OF DISCUSSION

Oklahoma's education system faces serious challenges. Only 26% of students meet grade-level expectations in reading and math, graduation rates remain below state goal, and Oklahoma ranks near the bottom nationally in PreK-12 outcomes. While there are pockets of progress, too many students are still falling behind — making clear that incremental change is not enough. This reality raises a critical question: *How can Oklahoma reimagine the structure, content, and supports of education to better prepare students for the future?*

What is a Community Town Hall

A Community Town Hall is a local forum where residents and leaders discuss key issues affecting their area. Local input from these events will be collected and shared with the Oklahoma Academy. This feedback will help shape the statewide Town Hall in October, ensuring community voices guide policy recommendations for a more resilient Oklahoma.

How It Works:

- Each Community Town Hall will be facilitated using a structured format to encourage open dialogue and gather actionable input.
- Notes, key themes, and recommendations from these local discussions will be compiled and submitted to the Oklahoma Academy for a report.
- These local insights will directly inform the October statewide Town Hall conference, ensuring that the final recommendations reflect the lived experiences and priorities of communities across the state.

By connecting local voices to state-level policy discussions, the process ensures that Oklahoma's path forward is shaped by the people it will impact most.

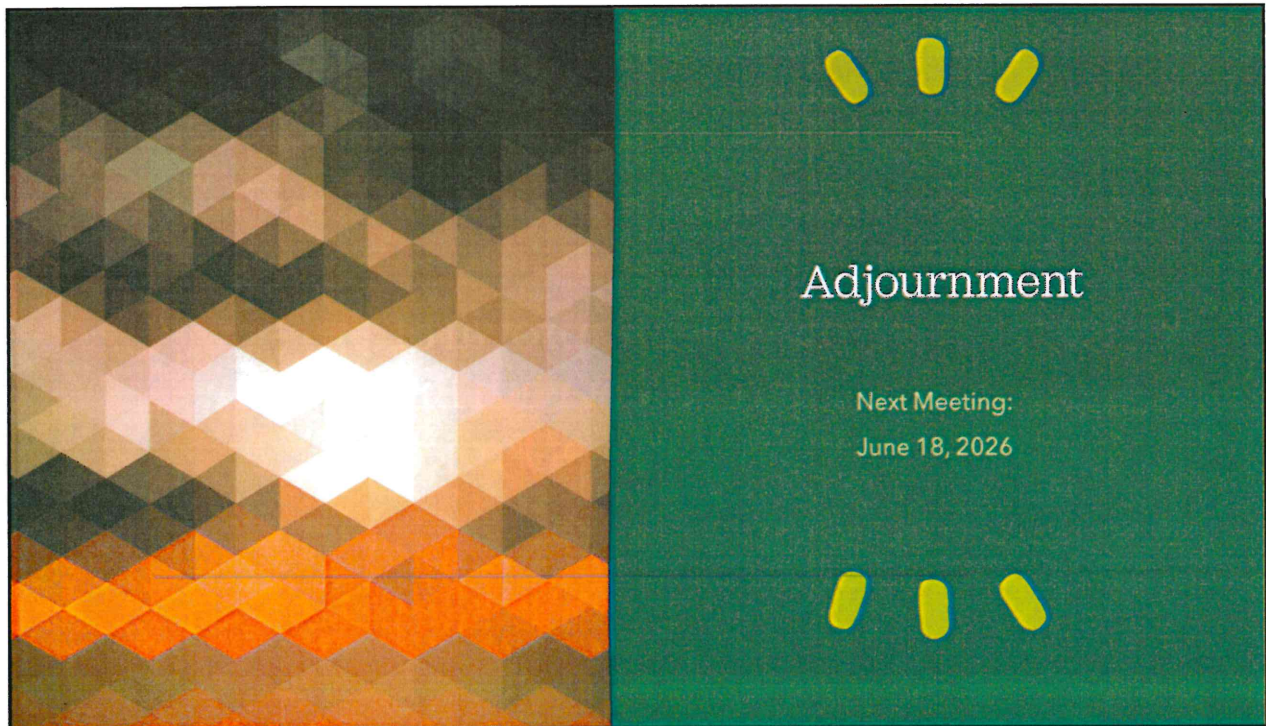
