

Program Objective

The objective of the Liberal Studies Associate in Arts is to prepare students for transfer to a bachelor degree granting institution.

Requirements for Graduation

- 1. Sixty-three designated semester credit hours.
- Grade of "C" or better required in at least 15 credit hours of Major Field Elective courses.
- 3. Grade Point Average of 2.0 or better.
- 4. Fifteen semester credit hours in attendance at SSC.
- 5. Completion of Graduate Exit Survey.
