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#### **Program Objective**

The objective of the Secondary Education Associate in Science – Chemistry Teacher Certification Emphasis is to prepare students for transfer to a bachelor's degree granting institution to major in chemistry with a concentration in teacher certification.

#### **Requirements for Graduation**

- 1. Sixty-two designated semester credit hours.
- 2. Grade of "C" or better required in all Major Field Requirement courses.
- 3. Grade Point Average of 2.0 or better.
- 4. Fifteen semester credit hours in attendance at SSC.
- 5. Completion of Graduate Exit Survey.

**Transfer Note:** A statewide transfer agreement guarantees students transferring to an Oklahoma public four-year university **with an associate in arts or associate in science degree** will satisfy all freshman and sophomore general education requirements at the four-year university.

#### **Teacher Certification Examinations:**
