Q: What degree can I get online?

A: We offer an Associates degree in Business, Psychology, Social Science, Computer Science, Child Development, Criminal Justice, Enterprise Development (General or Business emphasis) or Liberal Studies. We offer an Applied Associates degree in Business Operations and Applied Technology. We offer certificates in Child Development and Early College. Don't see your degree or certificate... don't worry any degree can be started in the Liberal Studies major.

Q: How much does it cost?

A: You can estimate around \$200 per credit hour for in-state tuition (\$400/hr for out-of-state students) and most classes are 3 credit hours. Don't let cost be a barrier to achieving your dreams! The Online Degree Office will do everything we can to help you receive aid and/or make plans to cover costs.

Q: How can I pay?

A: Our first goal will be to help you secure financial aid. However, if you do not qualify or don't receive enough to cover your entire balance, SSC does offer payment plans.

Q: How long does it take to get the degree?

A: This all depends on several factors. Your assigned Student Navigator will help you determine the right number of classes and will calculate for you how long it will take. However, it is very possible to get a complete Associates degree in as little as 18 months.

Q: Will all of my classes be online?

A: Yes!

Q: Could I take an in-person class if I wanted to?

A: Yes!

Q: Where do I get my books?

A: When you enroll, your Student Navigator will help you identify which books you need and the SSC Bookstore has all books available to be purchased online and shipped to you.

A: Seminole State College uses a learner management system called Brightspace (aka D2L). Once you're enrolled you will be provided with a SSC email and password that you'll use to log in.
