

Residence Hall Move-In for Fall 2026

When you arrive on your scheduled date and time for Move-In:

- You will first go to the Ben & Bonnie Walkingstick Student Services Center
- You may have two helpers on the day of move in
- Your helpers will have two hours with you to help you unload, move in, arrange your room after arriving at your residence hall
- Once your helper's vehicle(s) are unloaded they will need to park East of the ponds in one of the lots across campus or at the Haney Center, the building South of your residence hall off Highway 9 to free up space in the housing parking lots
- After your two hours with your helpers, they will need to leave the residence hall, this allows for more room for the additional students moving into the building
