A2 Exam Subject Areas

Critical Thinking Exam:

- 30 minutes
- 30 multiple-choice items
 - A Likert-type scale is used (e.g., Strongly Agree, Agree, Neutral, Disagree, Strongly Disagree).
 - All answers are correct, but the choice that requires the most critical thinking skill receives the maximum weight.
- Sub-categories:
 - Problem Solving: The process of inquiry in which the nurse seeks multiple facts to remove obstacles or resolve patient care problems.
 - Biases and Ethical Dilemmas: Ethical, legal, and moral issues, as well as biases nurses may have about patients and others.
 - Argument Analysis: Situations in which the nurse seeks to resolve conflicts or disagreements by considering multiple points of view.
 - Analysis of Data: The need to interpret patient data correctly, and decide if further nursing action is required.

Reading Comprehension Exam:

- 60 minutes
- 55 multiple-choice items
- Provides reading scenarios in order to measure reading comprehension, identifying the main idea, finding meaning of words in context, passage comprehension, making logical inferences, etc.

Biology:

- 25 minutes
- 30 multiple-choice items
- Covers biology basics, water, biological molecules, metabolism, cells, cellular respiration, photosynthesis, etc.

Anatomy and Physiology:

- 25 minutes
- 30 multiple-choice items
- Provides coverage of general terminology and anatomical structures and systems.
